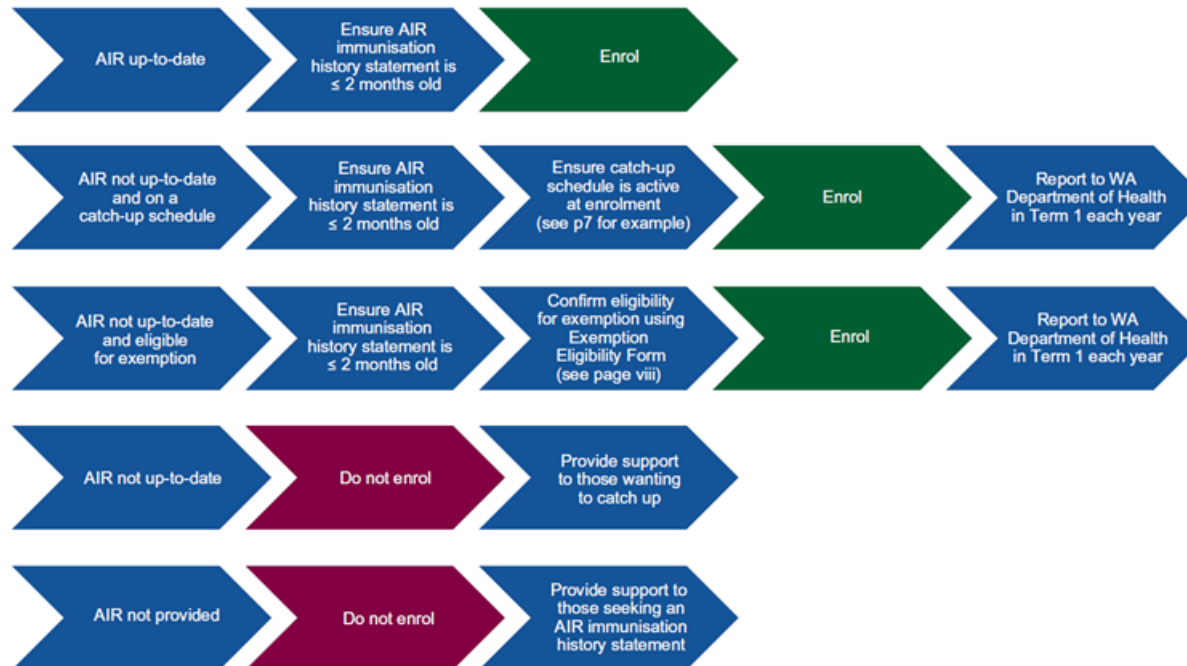


## IMMUNISATION REQUIREMENTS

### Enrolment in pre-kindergarten or kindergarten

At enrolment, families must provide a recent copy of their child's Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) immunisation history statement. This applies to families recently arrived from overseas as well.

Persons in charge must then assess whether a child meets immunisation requirements for enrolment. The flow chart below can be used for this purpose. This flow chart is on page vii of the [WA Immunisation Requirements: Guidelines for persons in charge of child care services, community kindergartens and schools](#).

## **Families from overseas**

Families who have arrived from overseas need to provide an AIR immunisation history statement for their children.

Overseas vaccination records must not be accepted.

Families will need to provide their child's overseas vaccination records to a local immunisation provider who can then register the child on AIR, upload the overseas vaccinations and provide any overdue vaccinations.
